MALE:

I hear tell of a ghost on horseback ... without a head. He is often seen in these parts hurrying along in the gloom of the night. As if on the wings of the wind in a nightly quest for his head. And the specter is known at all the campfires as the Headless Horseman of Sleepy Hollow.
